

Full Paper Submission Guidelines

We are happy to inform that Springer has accepted our proposal to bring out a Scopus indexed conference proceedings. Authors of accepted abstracts are invited to submit their full papers for consideration in the **Springer Conference Proceedings**.

Please ensure that your manuscript complies with the following requirements:

- The paper must be prepared in the **Springer Proceedings format**. The same is available at: <https://cms-resources.apps.public.k8s.springernature.io/springer-cms/rest/v1/content/26362278/data/v2>
- The manuscript should be **10–12 pages** in length (approximately **5,000–6,000 words including references**). Authors are requested to adhere strictly to the prescribed page and word limits.
- The **similarity index (excluding references)** must be **below 10%**.
- Papers must present original, unpublished research and should not be under consideration elsewhere.
- All submissions must strictly follow the **Springer formatting and submission guidelines**. Manuscripts that do not conform to the prescribed format will **not be considered for the blind review process**, irrespective of the payment of the registration fee.
- If Artificial Intelligence (AI) tools have been used in preparing the manuscript, authors must explicitly disclose the use of AI and indicate its extent or percentage of contribution in the paper.

Review Process

- All full papers will undergo a double-blind peer review, and only those accepted through the review process will be included in the Springer Conference Proceedings; payment of the conference registration fee does not guarantee publication.

Note: The full paper submission portal will be opened after the completion of the abstract review process. Authors are requested to regularly visit the conference website for updates on submission timelines and other announcements.
