Director's Message

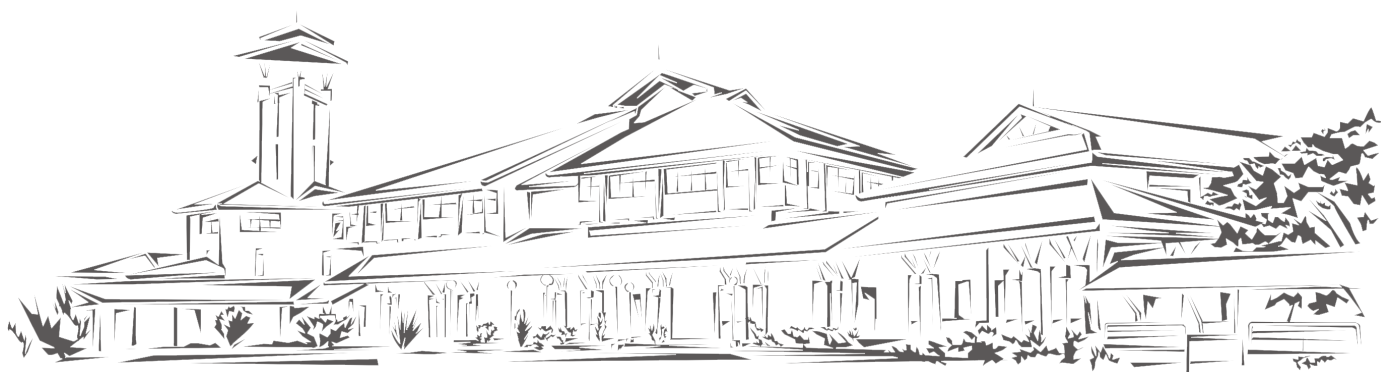
Information Systems Curriculum & Pedagogy Workshop at IIMK

A certificate of participation will be issued to participants under the aegis of AIS India Chapter and IIMK

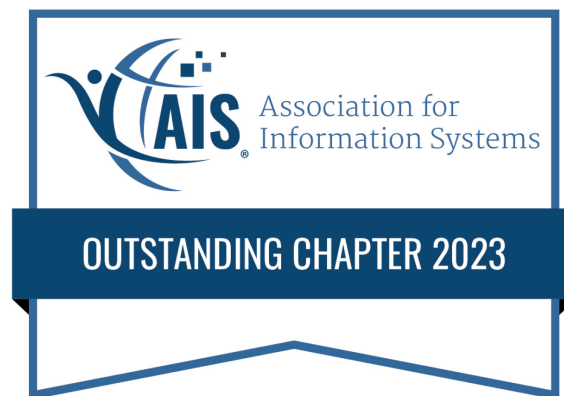
Accommodation
