Abstract:

This case focuses on how researchers have navigated a situation of non-cooperation from potential collaborators of a field experiment due to mistrust, coordination failure, informational asymmetry and data privacy problems arising from the involvement of a third party involved in the project. It explains the reasons for its failure to initially start the project and examines how the researchers navigated a new approach to deal with the crisis.
