9. What are the various facilities available to the students at IIM Kozhikode ?

The Institute has 20 well-designed hostels capable of accommodating about 1400 students. The classrooms, computer center, students canteen and all other facilities are within walking distance of the hostel. All the hostel rooms have been provided with a LAN and WIFI connection to cater to the computing needs of the students. The students are provided rooms on a single or sharing basis.

Washing machines, water dispensers and geysers are provided in all hostels. Most of the hostels have air conditioning facilities as well. Various sports facilities which include a table tennis room, a badminton court, two basketball courts, two football fields, volley ball court, squash court, swimming pool and a well-equipped gymnasium are available in the hostel premises. There are various recreational facilities available in the common rooms and music room. Three canteens cater to the food requirements of the students apart from doubling up as a night canteen for the nocturnal souls. There are different restaurants and kiosks available on the campus for some culinary retreats.

Hostel life is an integral part of the IIMK culture. Staying together, by sharing two years of their lives, the bond that is formed in these hallowed portals stays for life. Hostel bonding and other forms of interactions add to the vibrancy of the already colorful two years that one spends at IIMK. Be it late-night assignments, projects, studying for tests, or celebrating, the hostels never sleep.

10. What are the concessions and scholarships available for the students at IIM Kozhikode ?

Offered by the Institute

IIMK Merit Scholarship. IIMK Merit Scholarship is awarded to the students of Post Graduate Programmes (PGP, PGPLSM and PGPFIN) first and second year students on the basis of their performance during one academic year, as determined by their CGPA. The number of scholarships awarded is in the ratio of one scholarship for every 20 students in the first and second year

IIMK Need Based Financial Assistance (NBFA): IIMK Need Based Financial Assistance (NBFA) is offered by the Institute and the eligibility criteria are as under:

Students whose gross annual family income for the last financial year should be less than or equal to Rs. 8 lakhs.

Students who have availed an education loan from scheduled commercial bank to fund his or her studies at the Institute.

Students have to produce the loan disbursement details for the first year in the prescribed format issued by the bank authorities for being eligible to apply for IIMK NBFA for second year.

The student awardees of the scholarship should not have been involved in any act of academic indiscipline or misconduct at any time in the Institute.

A student who has received Financial Assistance/ Scholarship under any other scheme of the Institute or State/ Central government will not be eligible for IIMK NBFA.

Based on the financial score obtained during evaluation, a final rank list will be prepared by the Financial Aid Committee (FAC). The financial assistance will be disbursed based on the ascending order of the rank list, but within the NBFA budget approved for the academic year.

Offered by Central Government –

Top Class Education Scheme for SC Students: Offered by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India, to the students belonging to SC category based on annual parental income from all sources for the previous

financial year. The maximum income limit is Rs.8,00,000/-. The maximum number of scholarship allotted to IIM Kozhikode is 10 (as on date).

National Fellowship and Scholarship for Higher Education of ST Students: Offered by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India to the students belonging to ST category, based on annual parental income from all sources for the previous financial year. The maximum income limit is Rs.6,00,000/-. There is no Institute wise/state wise/stream wise ceiling of number of slots.

Merit Cum Means Scholarship for Professional and Technical Courses CS: Offered by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India, to the students belonging to minority communities, who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination. The maximum limit of income for the previous financial year is Rs.2,50,000. Muslims, Sikhs, Christians, Buddhists, Jain and Zoroastrians (Parsis) have been notified as minority communities.

Scholarships for Top Class Education for students with disabilities

Offered by the Ministry of Empowerment of person with disabilities, Government of India to the students with disabilities of 40% and above and having a valid certificate of disability as prescribed under rules issued by the competent authority. The maximum limit of income of parents/guardians from all sources should not exceed Rs.8,00,000/-.

Prime Ministers Scholarship Scheme for the wards of Central Armed Police Forces, Assam Rifles & state police personnel Ministry of Home Affairs:

Offered by Ministry of Home Affairs, to the wards/ widows of CAPFs & AR. APFs & AR personnel died in harness/ election duty, wards or personnel disabled due to causes attributable to Govt. services and Wards of Ex CAPFs & AR personnel in receipt of Gallantry awards. Applicant should have minimum 60% marks in Minimum Entry Qualification (MEQ) i.e. 10+2/Diploma/Graduation or equivalent in case of new applicant.

12. What is weather condition at Kozhikode?

Kozhikode has generally a dry climate apart from the monsoon months June to September where the atmosphere remains slightly humid and warm. January to

May are hot summer days with average maximum temperature above 35-40°C while the months October to December are winter with moderate temperature.
