About IIM Kozhikode

The fifth IIM to be established by Govt. of India in 1996, IIMK started its academic journey in 1997 with its flagship Postgraduate Program (PGP). The Institute is on a high growth trajectory today, offering widest range of academic programs in the field of management education. These include Doctoral Programme in Management (PhD), Executive PG Programmes, Management Development Programmes and Faculty Development Programs. IIMK set up a Satellite campus at Infopark, Kochi, in 2013 dedicated to Executive Education. IIMK has also the unique distinction of launching a PhD (Practice Track) programme for working professionals besides bringing in new dynamic courses like one-year Post Graduate programme in Business Leadership (2019) MBA in Finance and MBA in Liberal Studies & Management (2020). IIM Kozhikode also launched a one-of-its kind 4-year full-time undergraduate programme – Bachelor of Management studies in 2025.

The institute is also home to IIMK LIVE a first-of-its-kind startup incubation programme, the Indian Business Museum and seven other Centres of Excellences encompassing diverse areas. IIMK is ranked 3rd as per NIRF India Rankings 2025: Management. The institute also made its global debut for its flagship MBA and EMBA programme in the 2020/21 QS World University Rankings. In 2023, IIM Kozhikode also broke into Top-100 in Financial Times Ranking for Masters in Management (MBA) and gained 9 spots in 2024 to reach global #68. The Institute also attained global rank #70 in the FT Open Enrolment Programme for 2024. The Institute is globally accredited by EQUIS (EFMD) and AMBA (UK).

IIM Kozhikode invites international scholars to participate in the Distinguished Visiting Scholar (DVS) Programme – a prestigious 1–3 month residential fellowship aimed at advancing academic engagement, fostering high-impact research, and strengthening global academic linkages. The DVS Programme is open to distinguished scholars from premier institutions worldwide who have demonstrated sustained record of excellence in research and teaching in management or allied disciplines. During their residency in the 2026–27 academic year, visiting scholars collaborate closely with IIMK faculty and students through joint research initiatives, seminars, mentoring, and selective teaching contributions. Their presence enriches IIMK’s academic environment by bringing global perspectives, supporting joint publications, and nurturing long-term international partnerships.

The DVS programme aims to:

Facilitate cutting edge, collaborative research with IIMK faculty and doctoral scholars

Enrich academic discourse through seminars, workshops, and guest lectures

Strengthen long term institutional partnerships and joint publications

Contribute to executive and postgraduate teaching, mentoring, and curriculum development

Role & Contributions of Visiting Scholars

Distinguished Visiting Scholars are expected to:

- ✓ Undertake state of the art research in partnership with one or more IIMK faculty members
- ✓ Present public seminars and research talks for faculty, doctoral students and research groups
- ✓ Contribute voluntarily to selected teaching activities (postgraduate, executive or FPM modules) where feasible
- ✓ Mentor doctoral and early career researchers and engage in scholarly exchanges

Who Should Apply?

Ideal candidates will have:



A distinguished record of scholarship from premier institutions outside India



Demonstrated excellence in research (publications in top tier journals) and/or postgraduate/executive teaching



A clear plan for collaboration that benefits IIMK in terms of research outputs, co authorship, joint grant proposals, and academic exchange

Note: Past DVS visitors are eligible to apply again only after a gap of five academic years from their last visit.





Inclusions

Selected DVS fellows will receive:

- ✦ Daily subsistence allowance for the duration of stay
- ✦ Return economy airfare from the parent institution to IIM Kozhikode (shortest route)
- ✦ Local travel allowance for arrival/ departure and official local travel
- ✦ On campus accommodation (rent free) subject to availability
- ✦ Office facilities: Dedicated workspace, computing access and library privileges
- ✦ Administrative support for visas, local logistics and campus integration



Expected Outcomes

- Joint research papers, conference presentations and other scholarly outputs that acknowledge IIM Kozhikode
- Workshops, special lectures and short courses delivered for faculty, students and practitioners
- Strengthened international linkages and potential future collaborative programmes



Selection & Announcement

- DVS fellowships are awarded competitively by IIM Kozhikode through a review of scholarly fit, proposed contribution, and institutional partnership potential.
- Up to eight scholars will be selected each academic year, one typically from each academic area.

Application Process

Interested candidates should submit the following documents via email to ec-globe-office@iimk.ac.in no later than 31 January 2026:

1. Cover letter outlining the candidate's proposed contribution to IIM Kozhikode (research, teaching, seminars and collaborations)
2. Abstract of the research project proposed to be pursued during the visit, including names of the proposed IIMK faculty partner(s)
3. Curriculum Vitae
4. A recommendation letter from the IIMK faculty member with whom the proposed collaborative work will be carried out
