With a view to support the Govt. of India's vision of being Net-zero in carbon emissions by 2070, the Centre for CLIMATE Studies (CCS) was set up at the Institute to provide a platform for CLIMATE talks and research, develop CLIMATE ambassadors etc.

A key initiative of CCS is to first understand our status vis-à-vis carbon impact of our campus and second, identify and implement solutions (power, water, food, waste, transportation etc.) that would help move our campus towards the aspiration of carbon neutrality. This would require

- (a) collation of relevant data and information to arrive at an estimate of the carbon impact of our campus activities, and
- (b) interaction with external experts and service providers to understand the various solutions/ options available to us to improve the carbon footprint of our campus.

In order to undertake and execute the above tasks, the following Carbon-neutral Campus Technical (CNCT) Committee is constituted with immediate effect:

The Committee would meet regularly to evaluate various carbon impact reduction proposals sourced by CCS. The Committee would present its techno-managerial evaluation of proposed solutions to the Competent Authority. In the first year, at least 3 proposed solutions would be evaluated by the CNCT Committee.

The term of the Committee will be for a period of two years.
